Tiebreakers

M7

- **Ranking of teams in prelim groups in M7 format (CPL + SPL + Division 1 + Division2)**
 1. number of games won
 2. difference between rounds won and lost
 3. if 2 teams tied result of direct match-up in current round
 4. if 3 teams tied higher number of rounds won
 5. if 3 teams tied result of direct match-up in current round
 6. seeding

- **In all other rounds there is always the winner advancing, no ties possible**

- **Tournament ranking in M7 format (CPL + SPL + Division 1 + Division2)**
 1. ranks 1-4 decided by final games
 2. losers of quarterfinals and ocho finals are ranked by
 - a) difference between rounds won and lost
 - b) higher number of rounds won
 - c) higher number of games won in whole tournament
 - d) difference between rounds won and lost in whole tournament
 - e) higher number of rounds won in whole tournament
 - f) result of latest direct match-up in tournament
 - g) seeding
 3. losers of prelims are ranked by
 - a) number of games won
 - b) difference between rounds won and lost
 - c) higher number of rounds won
 - d) result of direct match-up in tournament
 - e) seeding

- **Overall ranking of teams in M7 format (CPL + SPL + Division 1 + Division2)**
 1. teams get points for the overall ranking according to the CPL, SPL, Division 1 and Division 2 point table respectively
 2. CPL point table:
